## Tips and tricks to stimulate appropriate care

### Short description

Studies on waste in health care have shown that the largest share lies in the inappropriate use of health services. Our inspection services invest a lot in checking the reality and conformity of healthcare services, on the basis of well-established regulations. Tackling 'inappropriate care' however requires a different frame of reference, scientific evidence or indicators of good practice to carry out actions aimed at stimulating proper use of health services.
