Short description

We attend all participants to be aware for the importance to have and develop integrity programmes on their organizations, and will explain how they can do it, particularly with reference to public procurement and its linked data treatment and processing (The Italian Red Cross will present its very relevant project concerning data standardization during covid-19 pandemic), according to OECD recommendation (OECD 2020) on using or expanding e-procurement platforms to record transactional information on the procurement of emergency item. Based on our institutional practices and experience, supported by the recent advice of the expert panel on effective ways of investing in Health concerning the organization of resilient health and social care following the covid-19 pandemic. We will demonstrate how we audit the integrity framework of the healthcare providers.
