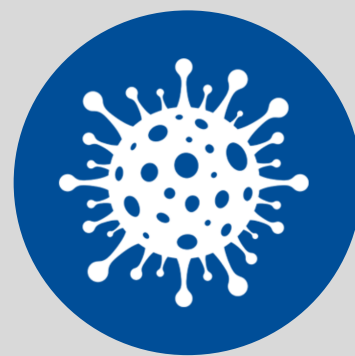

Since its inception in 1995, the Corruption Perceptions Index from Transparency International has become the leading global indicator of public sector corruption. Their report reveals that persistent corruption is undermining health care systems and contributing to democratic backsliding amid the COVID-19 pandemic. Explanations & recommendations.

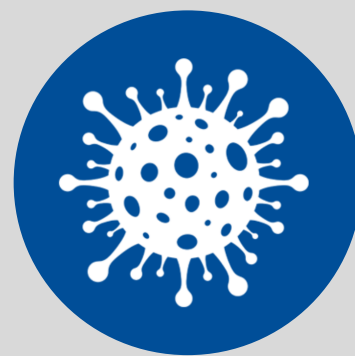
